

RoHS and 5X explained:

What does RoHS Compliant really mean?

The RoHS European Union Directive stands for “the restriction of the use of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment.” This Directive certifies that our USB flash drives contain no more than the agreed levels of hazardous substances which harm the environment. iClick flash drives that are RoHS compliant are better for the environment because the materials used, such as lead-free solders, are more easily decomposed than their traditional counterparts. The hazardous materials which are limited by the RoHS Directive are as follows:

- Lead
- Cadmium
- Mercury
- Hexavalent Chromium,
- Polybrominated Biphenyl (PBB) flame retardants
- Polybrominated Diphenyl Ether (PBDE flame retardants)
